KEY EXPECTATIONS

This is a 1-year commitment within the project, and willingness to serve on a Board for 2-3 years.

- Attend onboarding/kickoff session
- Use of CapacityGOV app
- Enroll in Modern Board and complete the Essentials of Governance Course
- Participate in at least 3 study group discussions
- Join MatchBoard
 - Research and identify 3 community-serving organizations, seeking new board members
 - Prepare for interviews with the prospective organizations
- Prepare an alternate plan for engagement in other community roles
- Take part in Capacity Canada's Governance BootCamp if selected
- Respond to Capacity Canada Surveys
- Consent to and cooperation in being featured as a case study for project communications
